## Planning for the future at Reigate & Banstead Redhill Town Centre-----Consultation

## Sustainable Transport Response Notes:

<u>Dear Sir</u>

1.0 SUSTAINABILITY;-

What are the population growth targets over what period ? What Climate changes are anticipated;- eg. The effect of a rising sea level & population migration from low coastal lands and river estuaries?

The long term provision of a potable water supply ?

What carbon costs;- eg. The effect of fuel costs & carbon tax ?

#### What figures have been used ?

2.0 RAIL TRANSPORT;- Predicted growth and Capacity ?

It is assumed that recent predictions are correct and that more capacity will be required within the decade. ie, Extra Track & platform facilities.

2.1 A possible Interim solution;-

Provide for a Grade Separated Junction for Reading / Tonbridge Gatwick line and reduce demand on main line station.

2.2 Action required

Do not build on land required for a new railway layout.
