PLANNING, ECONOMIC **PROSPERITY &** PARKS: R&B

LEVY for SAFE PEDESTRIAN & CYCLE ROUTES TO SCHOOL, **COLLEGE & RAIL STATIONS ;-**

1.0 Proposed paths + cycle lane options;-

1.1 On WEST side of A217 Cockshot Hill :- a path and cycle lane be provided on service roads, redundant guarry land, road verge, and Park footpath between Woodhatch and Reigate for the benefit and safety of the new population.

1.2 On Park Lane (West) A cycle route (vehicles restricted to access only), an upgraded path route via R of W, Nos.17,18 and 58, to the High Street, and the West side of London Road (on purchased land)) and to schools, college and Rail Station. All as shown on the attached sketch. For the safety of the new population

1.3 On Lonesome Lane (vehicles restricted to access) from the Horley Development area to (1.1 above) Cockshot Hill with alternative route through the Woodhatch development area to Park Lane (West). This is proposed because fast and heavy traffic on the relatively narrow A217 with deep ditches is not safe for cyclists.

1.4 Other safe routes are possible and are shown including an off road cycle route from Woodhatch to the Hospital and a cycle route at Frenches Road. But noise and air pollution and safety problems at R of W, No.87 and at School Hill need other solutions for the new population within the proposed Merstham development areas.
